About the Awards for Academic Excellence

Context

The Canadian Institute of Planners' (CIP) annual Awards for Academic Excellence recognize one student from each of the accredited planning programs (undergraduate and graduate) across Canada who has achieved academic excellence.

The head of each accredited planning program shall identify the individual who meets the criteria for the award and inform CIP of their selection.

The Award will consist of a certificate bearing the CIP seal, and a book prize.

The Award shall be presented at an appropriate formal university event. If possible, a CIP Director or designated representative will attend the event to present the award.

Eligibility

Eligibility for the award is limited to full-time student members of CIP, enrolled in accredited planning programs in Canada. Where more than one program is accredited at one university, one award will be given for each program.

The award shall be granted to the student member who achieves the highest academic standing over the length of the program.
