About the Plan Canada Awards

Context

In 1997, the *Plan Canada* Awards were introduced to recognize the best short and feature articles published in *Plan Canada* the preceding year.

Articles are evaluated by the *Plan Canada* Awards jury and judged according to: the extent to which the article serves the needs and interests of *Plan Canada* readers; writing style and clarity; good journalism (including insight, imagination, depth of reporting and analysis); and demonstrated leadership and innovation.

Eligibility

All articles published during the preceding year are considered for the awards.

Articles are placed into one of the following two categories by the Chair of the *Plan Canada* Editorial Committee:

- Feature Article of the Year: The most prominent and longest article of the Plan Canada issue in which it appears. (Sets the tone for that edition of the publication, was of high quality and typically longer in length). Only one feature article per edition.
- Short of the Year: Shorter in length and not a feature article in the Plan Canada issue in which it appears.
